DOUBLE-EDGE: FOLKESTONE TRIENNIAL, VARIOUS LOCATIONS, KENT, ENGLAND, 2017

2 September - 5 November 2017

Internationally recognised artists have been commissioned to create a collection of new artworks to be exhibited in Folkestone's public spaces under the title *double edge*, with some of the works due to remain in the town to add to its expanding art collection, Folkestone Artworks.
