*GALLERY ONE is the Corcoran's ongoing series of exhibitions devoted to the examination of current trends in the visual arts.*

*Filling the entire GALLERY ONE space, Antony Gormley's **Field** presents an impenetrable mass of seemingly generic forms which is alternatively humorous and poignantly evocative of humanity. These thousands of terra-cotta figures (created in collaboration with the Texca Family in Cholula, Mexico) collectively address some of Gormley's essential themes: the individual and society; the real versus the ideal; the model and its representation.*
