The Arts Council is giving a large, recently completed sculpture by Antony Gormley a temporary London home on the Serpentine Gallery's North Lawn for two months, from 16 July - 14 September, prior to its permanent siting in a new Kent park in Singleton Village, south of Ashford.

Two Stones is one of three sculptures commissioned for Singleton as a result of a competition organised in 1979 by Kent County Council and the South East Arts Association. The Arts Council contributed to the cost of the commission through its <u>Art in Public Places</u> scheme. In Singleton the sculpture will be sited beside a lake in the public park which forms the centre of the Village Development Scheme.
